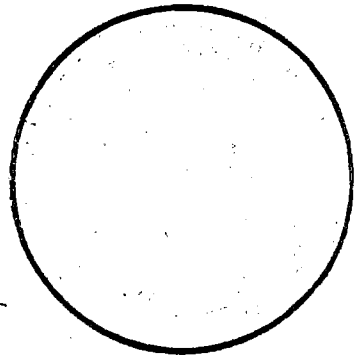

- (l) To Barbara Cartwright of 40 Cable Road Hoyleke the sum of THREE HUNDRED POUNDS
- (m) To Christine Speak of Peveril 22 Dovedale Road Leicester the sum of TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY POUNDS
- (n) To my Godchild Geraldine Alice Neade daughter of Gerald Neade of Aylescourt Road Liverpool 12 the sum of THREE HUNDRED POUNDS
- (o) To the Vicar and Church Wardens for the time being of St. James Church West Derby in the said City of Liverpool towards supplying flowers for the Altar the sum of ONE HUNDRED POUNDS

AND I DECLARE that the receipt of the person purporting to be the Treasurer of the said Church shall be a good and sufficient discharge to my Trustees who shall not be answerable for the application of the said money

5). I DEVISE AND BEQUEATH to my Trustees all my real and the remainder of my personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever including property over which I have a general power of appointment or disposition by Will Upon Trust that they shall sell call in collect and convert the same into money at such time or times and in such manner as they shall think proper with full power to postpone such sale calling in and conversion during such period as they shall think fit without being responsible for loss AND I DIRECT that my Trustees shall out of the proceeds of such sale calling in and conversion and out of my ready money pay my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses and the legacies hereby or by any Codicil hereto bequeathed and the duties on any such legacies as may be bequeathed free of duty

6). MY TRUSTEES shall hold the residue of the proceeds of such sale calling in and conversion and the property for the time being representing the same UPON TRUST to divide the same equally between the said Kathleen Hewitson and Constance
